A Children's Book With A Message That Transcends Generations

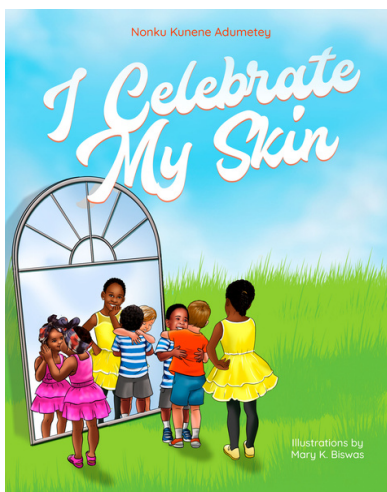
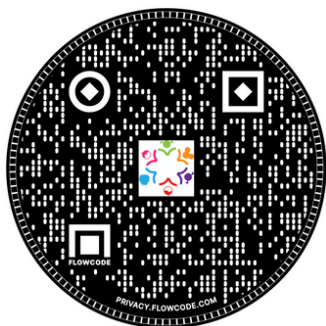
Children and adults alike learn an age-old lesson through this modern tale about colorism, confidence, and acceptance.
